## Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), approved by Congress and signed by former President Ronald Reagan, required public schools to inspect school building for asbestos-containing materials and to design a management plan to deal with any asbestos found in those buildings.

Clinton Prairie School Corporation is in compliance with the Federal EPA Guidelines and the appropriate responses as presented in the management plan. The law requires for re-inspection every three years by state inspectors. Clinton Prairie's facility was inspected in June, 2015 as required by statute. Periodic inspections are conducted every six month by Clinton Prairie Maintenance Staff. The school is currently in compliance with the law promoting and maintaining a healthy environment as related to asbestos.

In accordance with the US EPA's AHERA Standard (ref: 40 CFR 763.80), all information concerning asbestos-containing materials in the schools of the Clinton Prairie School Corporation is available for review during normal business hours by contacting the Clinton Prairie School Corporation Offices.
