

MINUTES OF MEETING

The Clinton Prairie School Corporation Board of Trustees met in regular session on August 20, 2019 at 6:30 P.M., at the administrative office, 2390 S County Rd 450 W, Frankfort, Indiana. Present were Board Members Bobbi Elliott, John Morris Travis Kelley and Cindy Neal, Superintendent Amanda Whitlock, Vicki Bailey as recording secretary, Joe Ciancio with Bakertilly Kirsten Clark and Becky Boddicker.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The agenda was approved on a motion by Mrs. Neal and a second by Mr. Morris. The vote was unanimous.

There were no public comments.

The consent agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Morris and a second by Mrs. Neal. The vote was unanimous. The consent agenda contained the July 16, 2019 minutes along with the claims up to August 20, 2019.

Joe Ciancio with Bakertilly presented a preliminary financing information for Clinton Prairie.

Mrs. Neal moved to approve the following staff recommendations. Resignation: Megan Griffy – Elementary PreSchool Instructor, Tommy Bracken – EL paraprofessional. New Hires: Michael Smith – Jr./Sr. High Spanish/EL Teacher, Morgan Smith – Jr./Sr. High Special Education Teacher, Natalia Guajardo – EL paraprofessional, Candace DeBord – Elementary PreSchool Instructor, JoAnne Brooks - Cafeteria.

Mr. Morris moved to approve the Teacher Appreciation Grant Resolution. Mrs. Neal seconded and the vote was unanimous

TEACHER APPRECIATION GRANT RESOLUTION

The Clinton Prairie School Corporation will distribute its Teacher Appreciation Grant monies received from the Indiana Department of Education to the teachers who meet the following criteria.

1. Employed in the classroom or directly provided education in a virtual classroom setting.
2. Received a Highly Effective or an Effective rating on their most recently completed performance evaluation, and
3. Employed on December 1st of the year the Corporation receives the Teacher Appreciation Grant monies.

The School Corporation will distribute its Teacher Appreciation Grant monies as follows:

1. To All Effective Teachers A stipend as determined by the superintendent.
2. To All Highly Effective Teachers A stipend in the amount of 25% more than the stipend given to Effective teachers.

The School Corporation will distribute the stipends within 20 business days of the distribution date by the Indiana Department of Education of the Teacher Appreciation Grant monies to the School Corporation.
