- **Prairie Teaching Staff**

- **Educational Foundation Teacher Grants**
The Clinton Prairie Education Foundation provided Teacher Grants of up to \$500 twice a year to support innovative classroom projects.
- **Professional Development**
We value continued support and growth of our teaching staff through purposeful and intentional professional development activities. We conduct an annual teacher retreat, provide various after hours and in house training programs that support our educational initiatives and meet the needs of our staff. Our recent focus has been on Depth of Knowledge and Student Engagement. We also have conducted extensive technology training in Google Apps and Canvas.
- **Proximity to a Variety of Living Arrangements**
Although many staff members choose to live in Frankfort or the Prairie community, we have many staff members who commute from Lafayette (20 minutes), and Zionsville (25 minutes). Our community is less than an hour from downtown Indianapolis.
